Dear Ms. Scanlon:

We have reviewed the proposed shellfish license allocations for 2025, and hereby approve them as follows:

Class	Subclass	Amount	Cost
Commercial	Resident	No Limit Set	\$200
Commercial	Nonresident	10%	\$400
Commercial	Senior Resident	No Limit Set	\$100
Commercial	Senior Nonresident	10%	\$200
Commercial	Junior/Student Resident	No Limit Set	\$100
Commercial	Junior/Student Nonresident	10%	\$200
Recreational	Resident	No Limit Set	\$20
Recreational	Nonresident	No Limit Set	\$40
Recreational	Week Nonresident	No Limit Set	\$20

The required 10% rule for issuing non-resident licenses is a minimum requirement and the town may choose to issue more than 10% if desired.

Licenses may be issued starting on July 1, 2025, following a minimum of 10 days advertising pursuant to Title 12. §6671 3-A. C.
