We are pleased to provide the annual report of the Maine Emergency Medical Service Run Report System (MEMSRR) for calendar year 2015.

The information in this report comes directly from the incident/patient care reports and licensure data. The report has been compiled in the following manner:

- Section 1:** Provides the agency demographic overview by service license, organization type, and license levels
- Section 2:** A summary of the response data collected from each report
- Section 3:** A breakdown of the transports to and from Maine hospitals
- Section 4:** An overview of agency response totals by region and month
- Section 5:** Provider demographics
- Section 6:** Reporting system compliance by region
- Section 7:** Continuing Education data

During 2015, the data collected within the MEMSRR was used in a variety of quality improvement reviews including a Maine EMS QI committee initiative reviewing patient refusals. EMS information is sought at a number of levels to help improve response, treatment, and patient survival. On a daily basis this information is used for syndromic surveillance by the Maine Center for Disease Control and Prevention. Fatal Motor Vehicle incidents are reviewed by the Maine Bureau for Highway Safety for planning purposes to improve the safety of our roads and highways. Plans for late 2016 will push EMS patient care reports into the state wide health information exchange. This will allow primary care providers, ER physicians, and any other health care profession that has contact with a patient access to any prehospital patient contact.

A reminder that the Maine EMS Rules require completed run reports to be submitted within one business day of a call. Timely submission of a complete and accurate patient care report is a critical component of providing quality patient care.

Thank you to all the services and providers who provide this information. The patient care and incident reports entered into the MEMSRR provide invaluable information that benefits our patients, our services, our individual practices, and our EMS system.

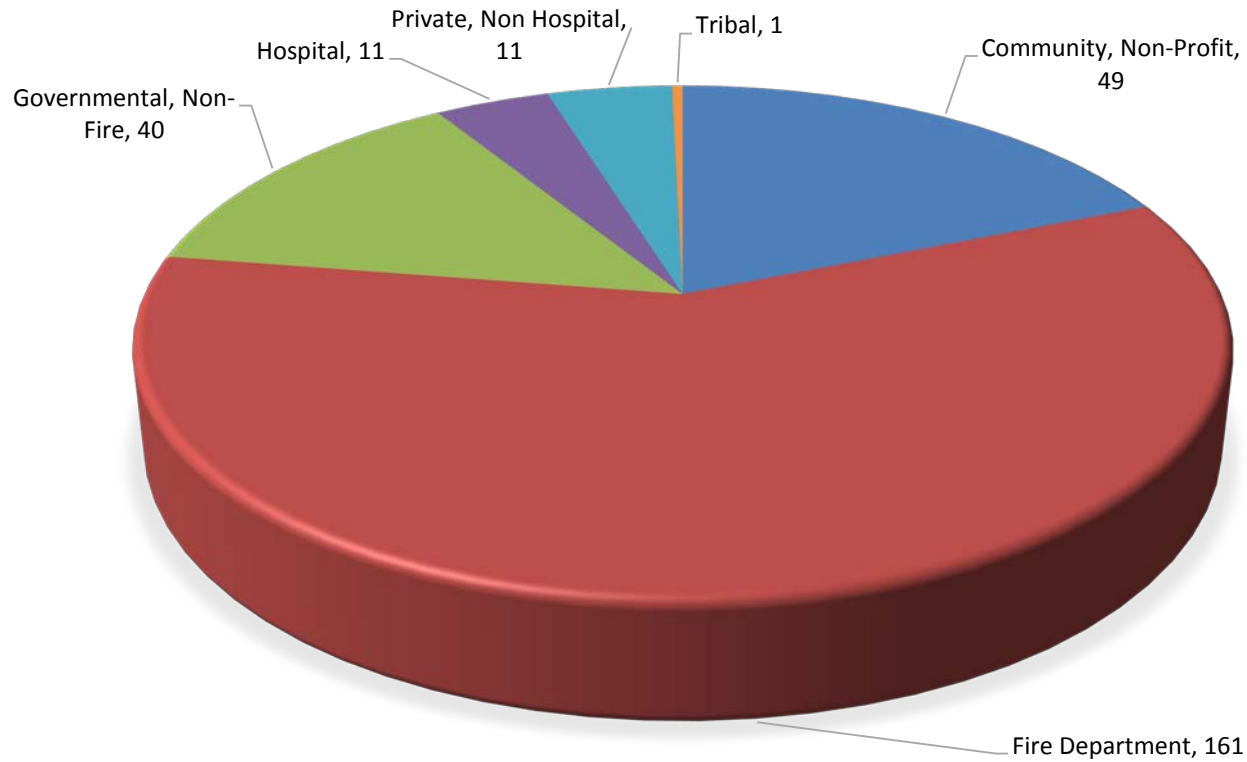

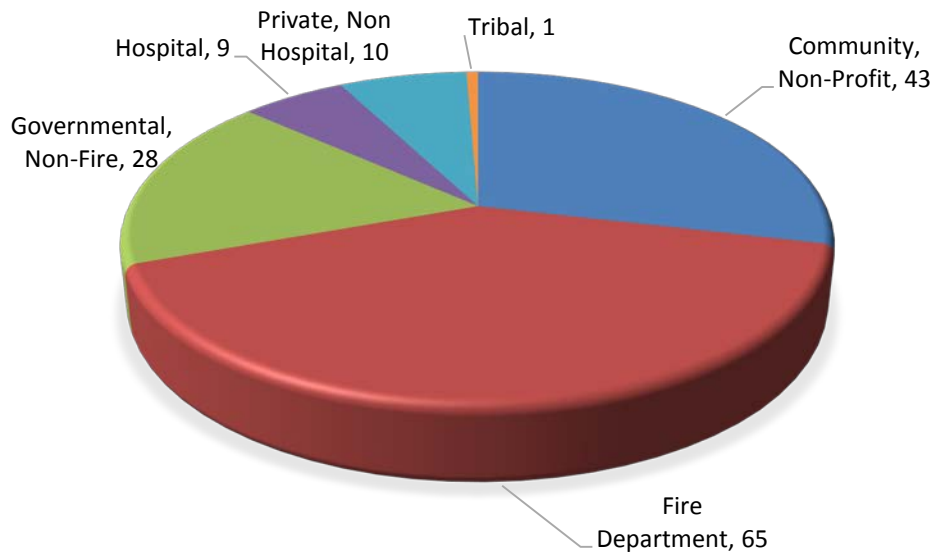

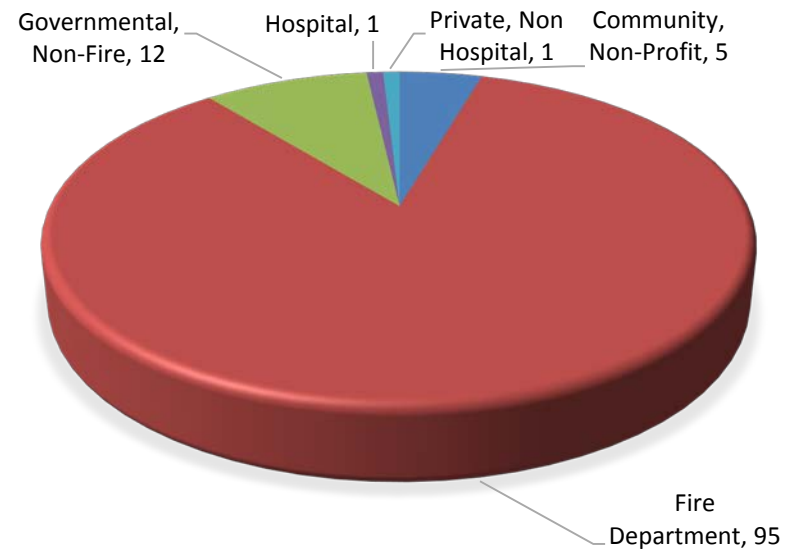

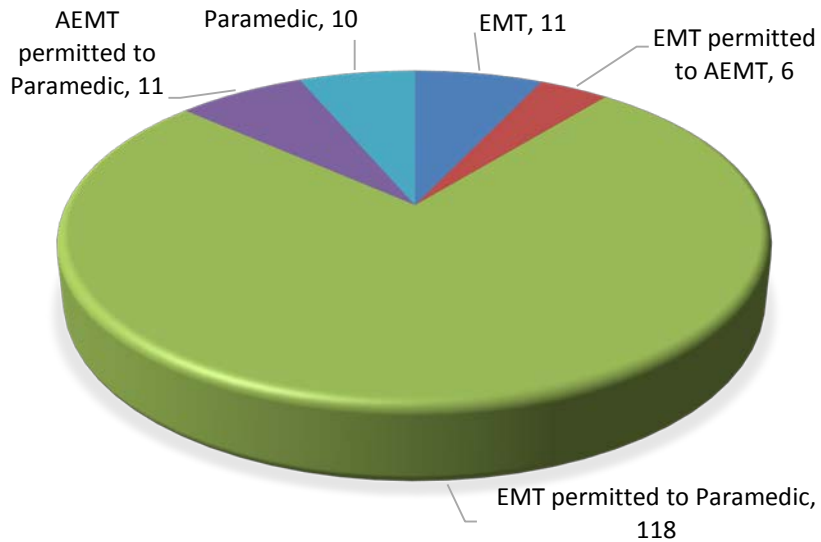

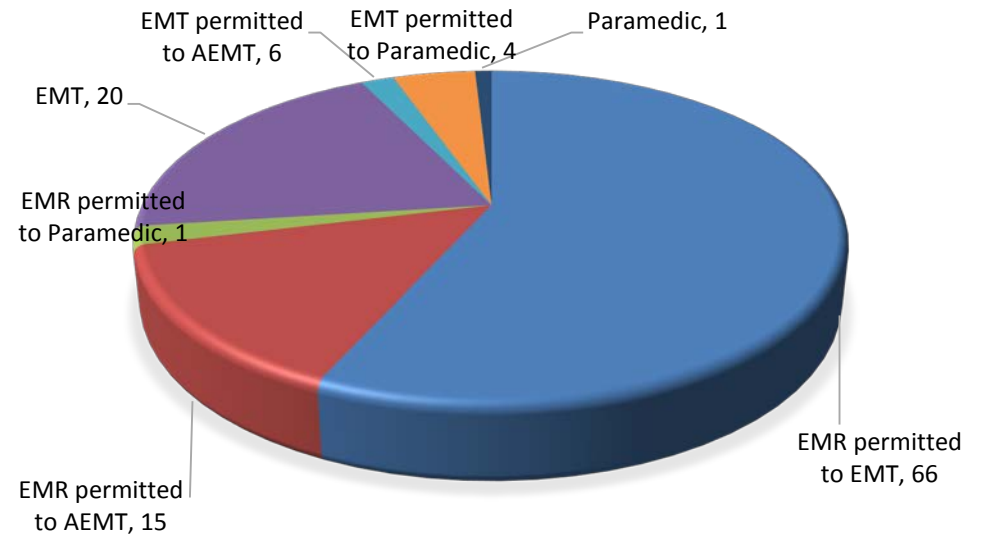
Type of Service by License Level

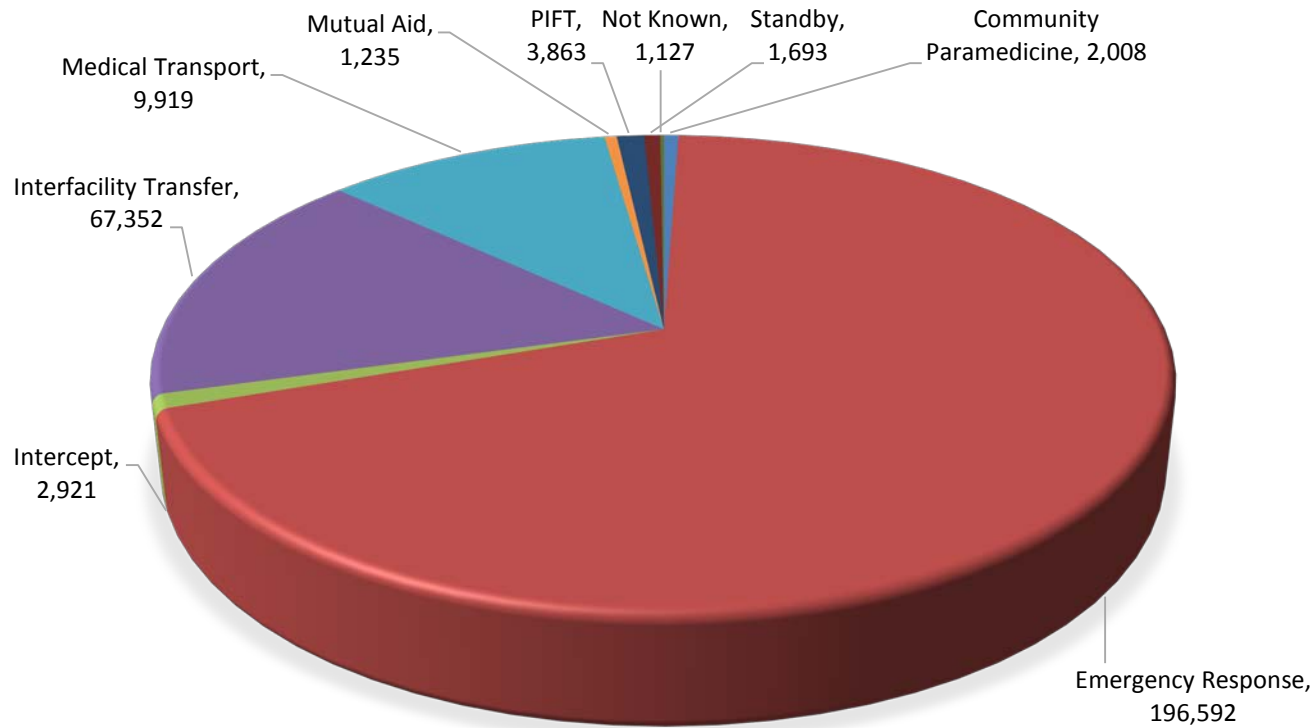

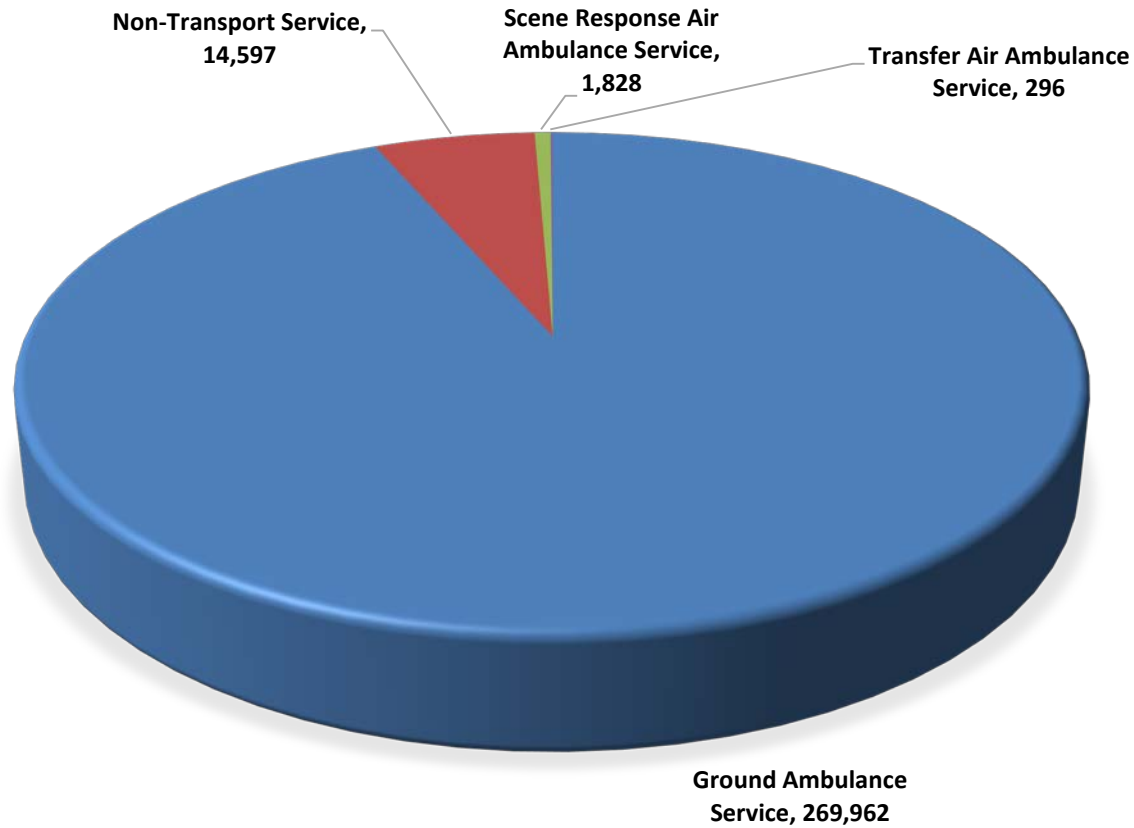

Incidents by Type of Service Requested



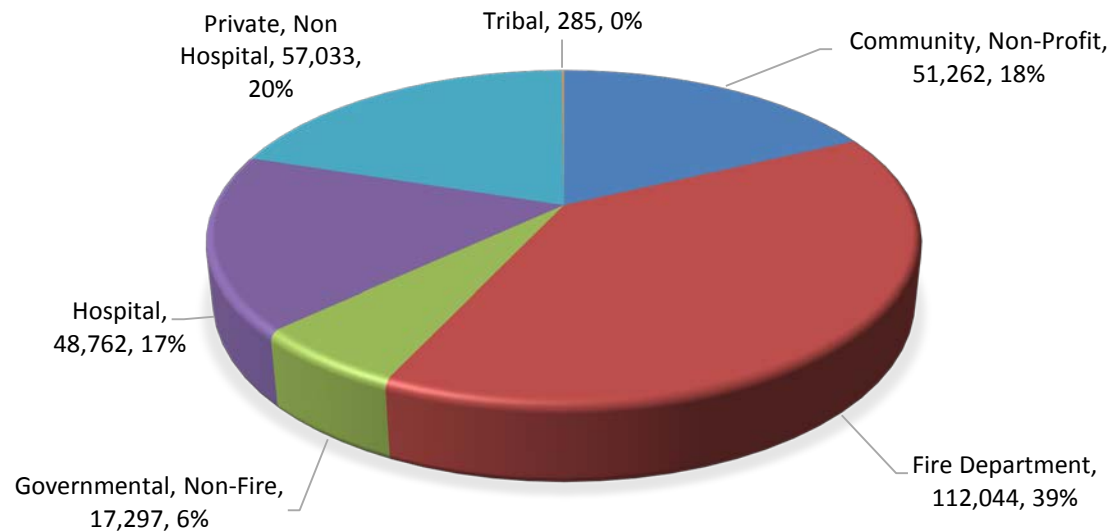

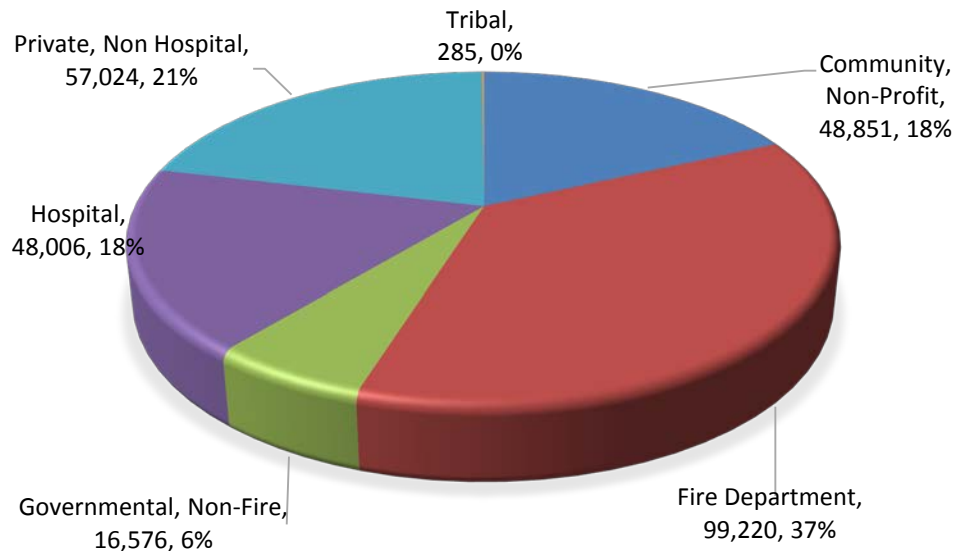

Response Volume by Organization Type

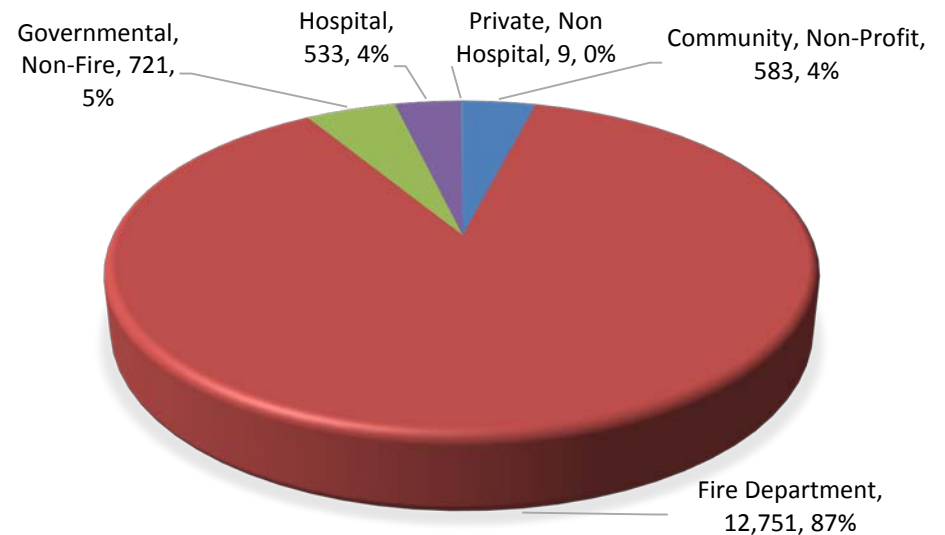

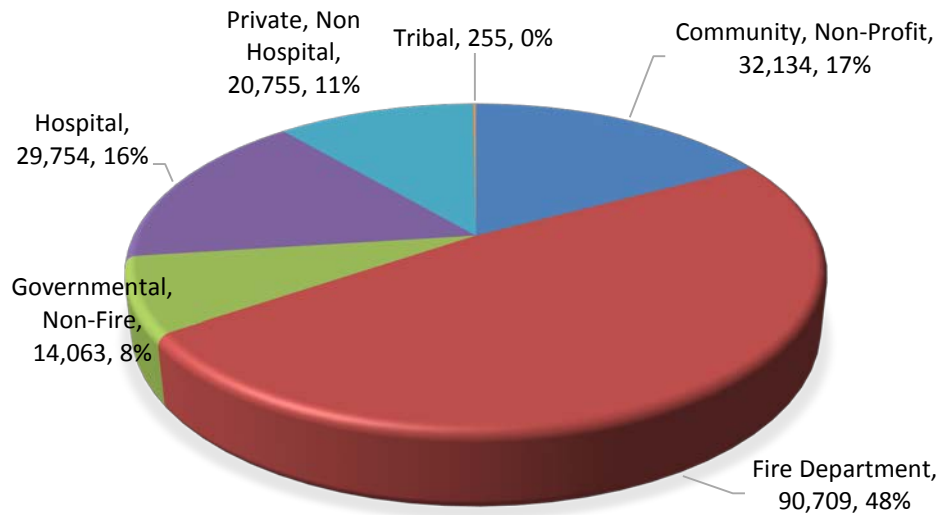

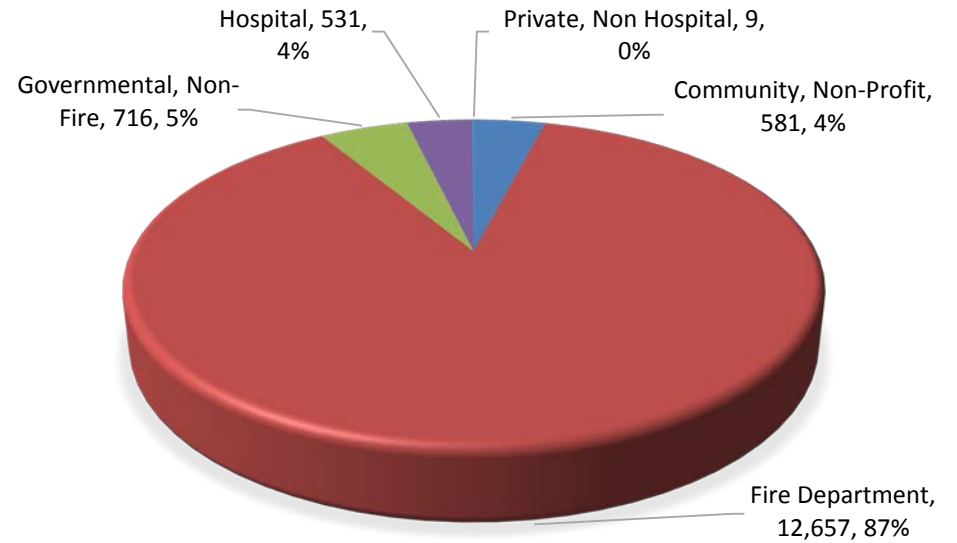
Emergency Response* by Organization Type

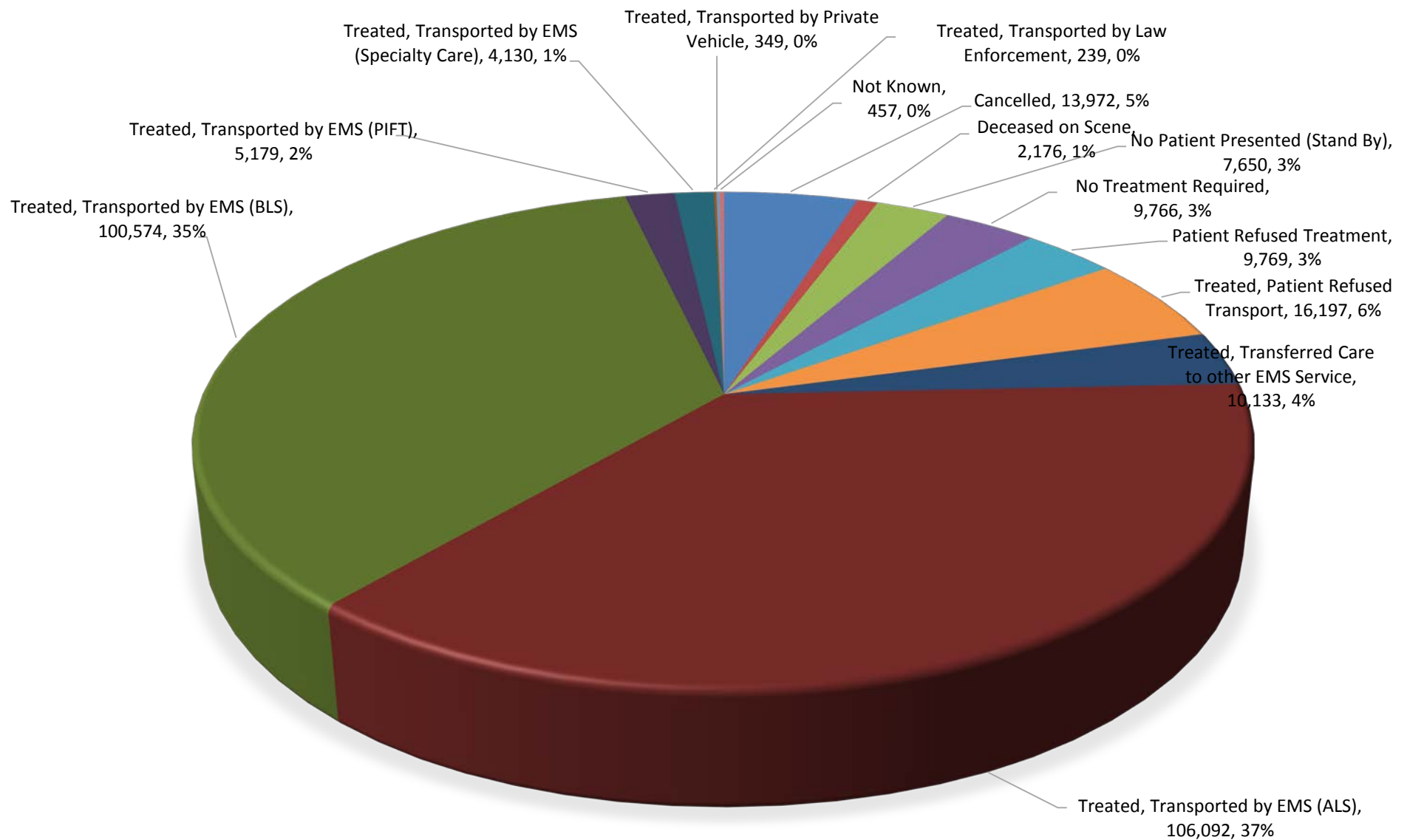

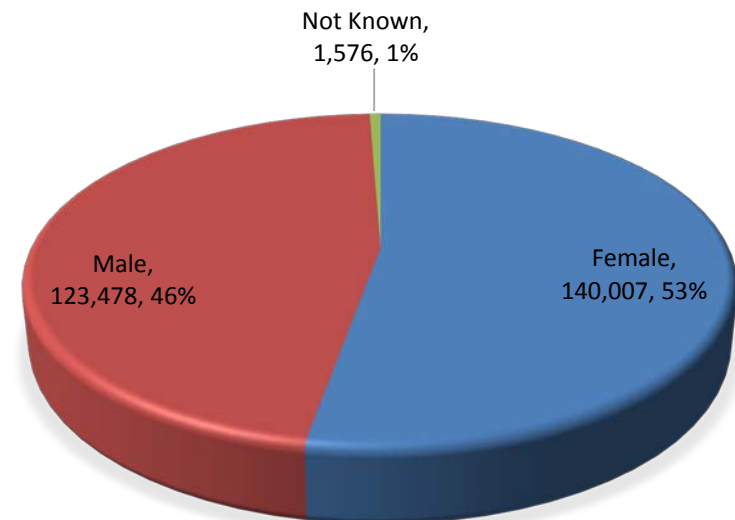

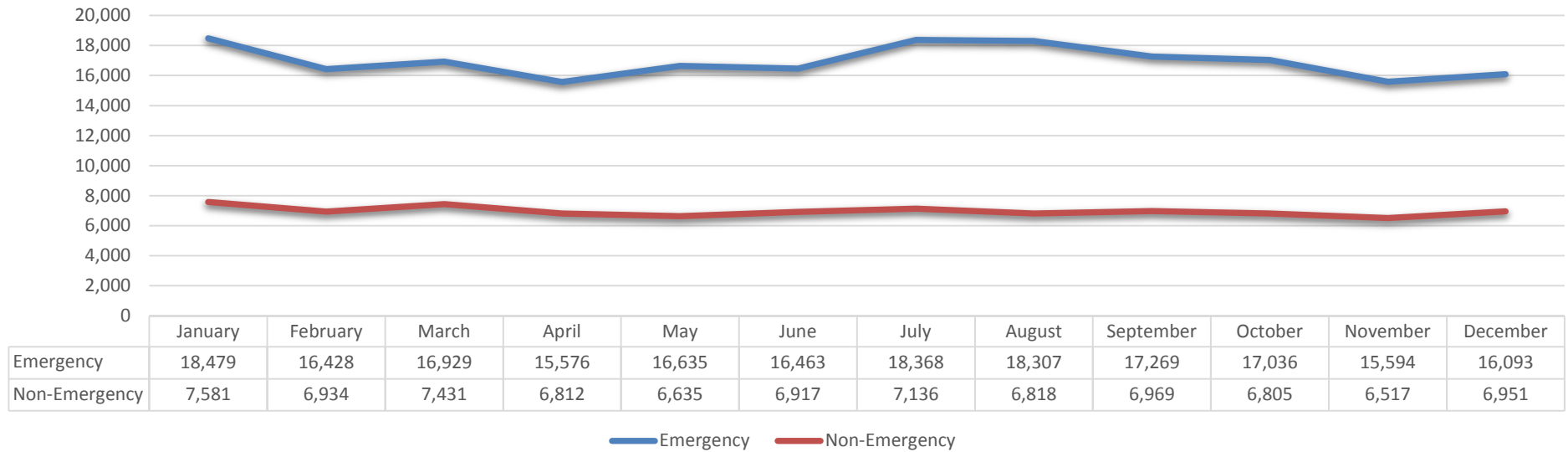

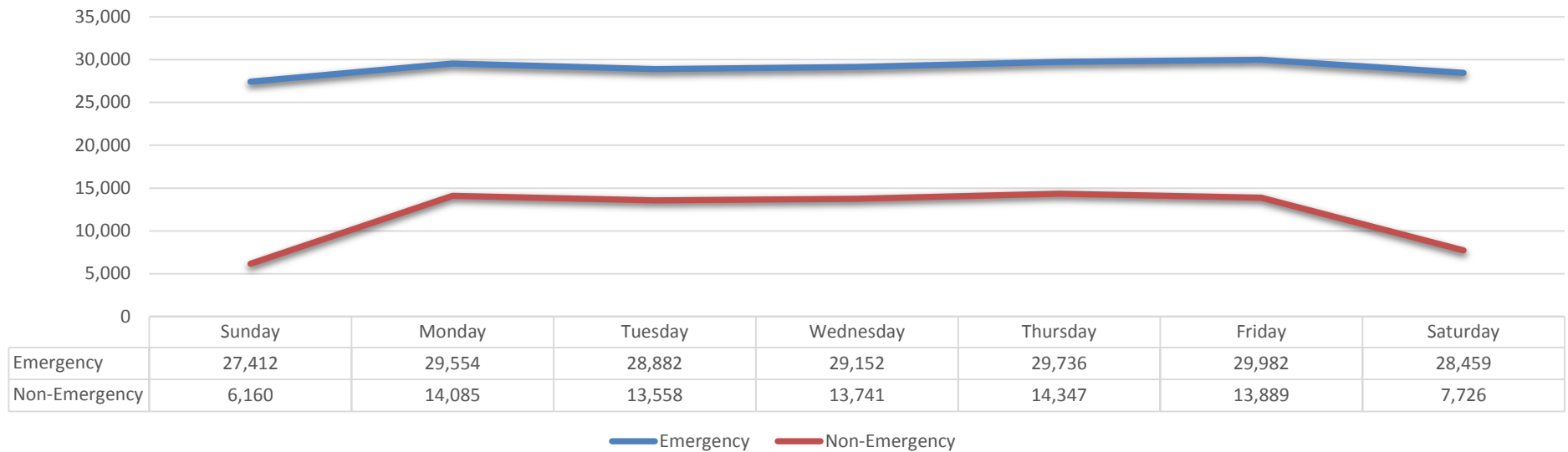

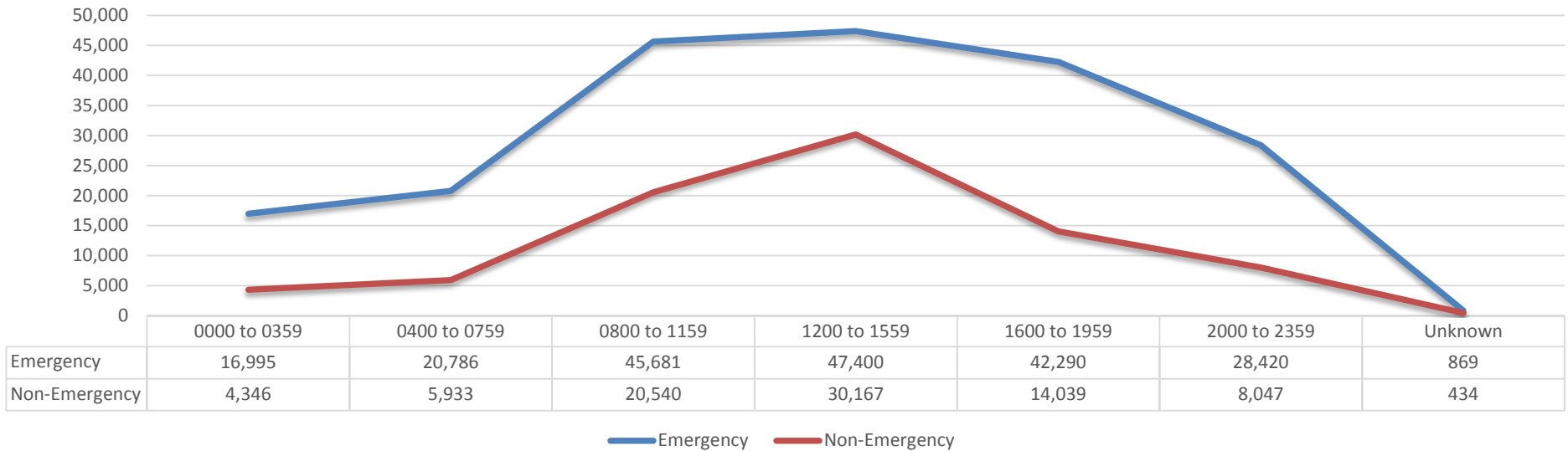
Response by Month

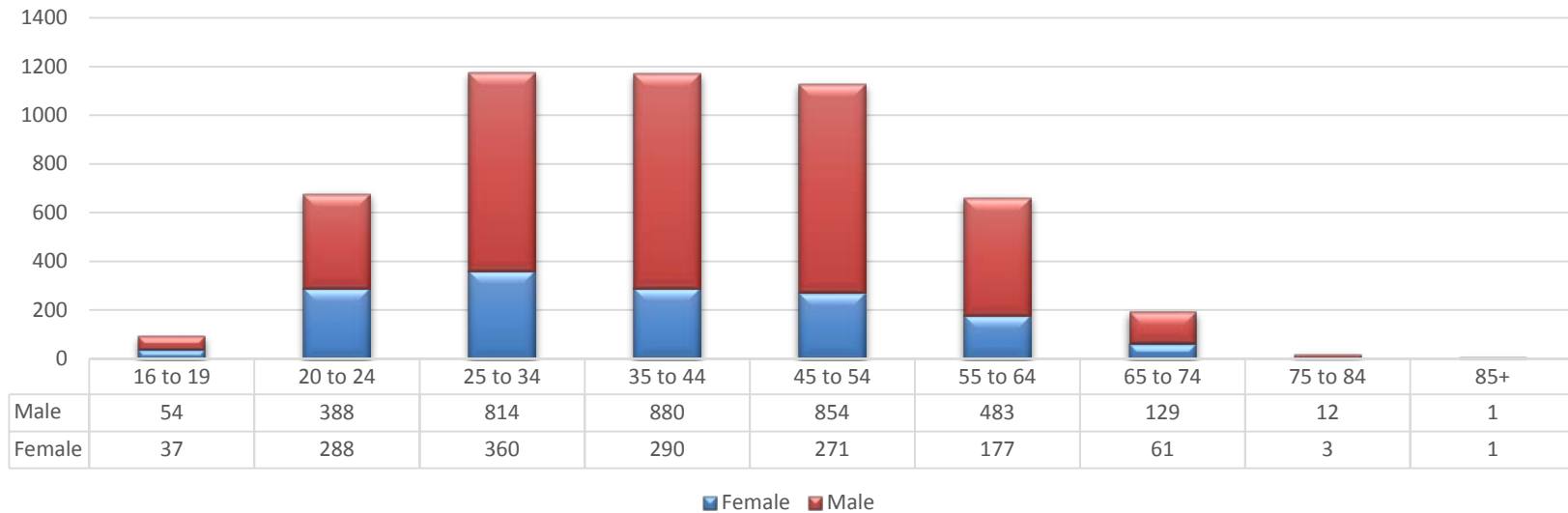

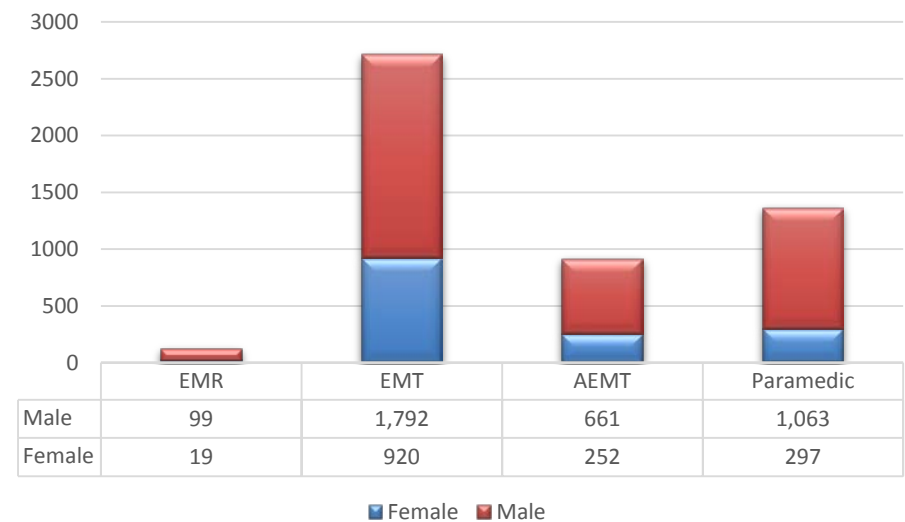

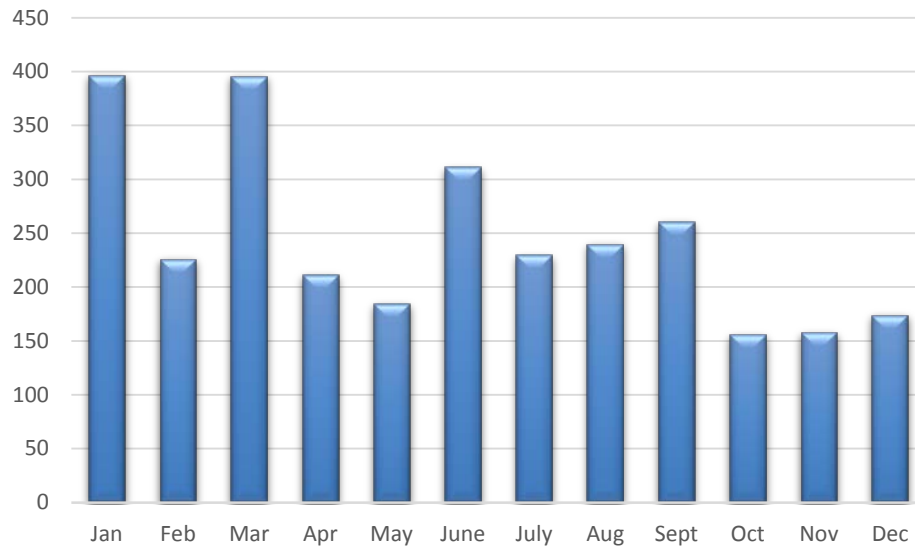

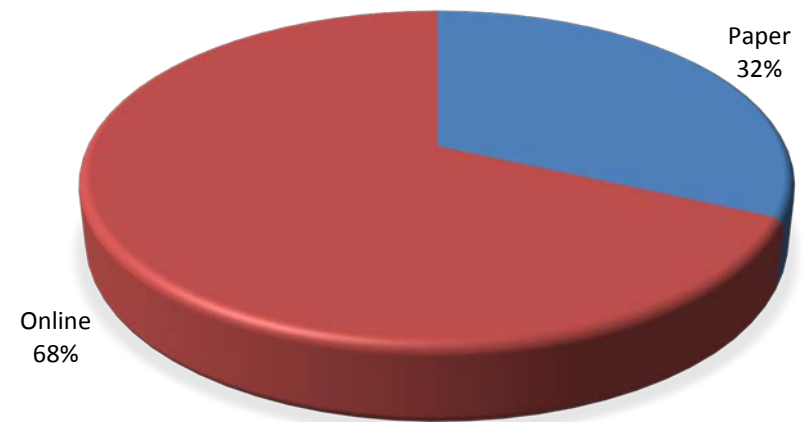
